

AUSABLE TOWNSHIP  
(Hunting & Firearms)  
ORDINANCE NO. 5  
Publication Date July 21, 1960

An ordinance to prohibit hunting or the discharge of firearms, air guns, spring guns, BB guns, pellet guns, bow and arrow or other dangerous weapons in certain sections of AuSable Township, and to provide penalties for the violation thereof:

THE TOWNSHIP OF AUSABLE, IOSCO COUNTY, ORDAINS:

1. It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt or pursue wild game, or except in lawful defense to discharge any firearms, airguns, spring guns, BB guns, pellet guns, bow and arrow or other dangerous weapons in that portion of AuSable Township bounded on the north by Division Street, and the AuSable River, on the west by the D. & M. Railway right or way, and on the south by Johnson Road and on the east by Lake Huron.
2. Any person who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction may be punished by a fine not exceeding \$100.00 or imprisonment for not exceeding 90 days or both in the discretion of the Court.
