

ORDINANCE NO. 13

**AN ORDINANCE TO PROMOTE THE SAFE USE OF
THE WATERS OF AUSABLE TOWNSHIP**

Effective: May 4, 1970

THE TOWNSHIP OF AU SABLE, COUNTY OF IOSCO, ORDAINS:

On the waters of the AuSable River, Sections 3, 4, and 10, Town 23 North, Range 9 East, Township of AuSable, and Sections 33 and 34, Town 24 North, Range 9 East, Township of Oscoda, County of Iosco, State of Michigan, from its mouth at Lake Huron upstream to the Detroit and Mackinaw railroad bridge, a distance of approximately 2-1/2 miles, no operator of any motorboat shall exceed a slow – no wake speed, which means a very slow speed whereby the wake or wash created by the motorboat would be minimal.

Violations of the provisions of the ordinance shall be deemed a misdemeanor and shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$100 for each such offense or imprisonment in the county jail for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days or both said fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.

This Ordinance shall become effective 30 days after passage.
